They can provide you with a list of documents you'll need, and help you complete your application or connect you with your local agency who is handling them. Your assistance could include past due and upcoming rent along with past due utilities. Don't miss out on this opportunity to not only catch up but get ahead!

Mortgage assistance. If you are behind on your mortgage, there may be local community organizations with funds to help you catch up. Also, stay tuned! The American Rescue Plan Act provides up to \$9.961 billion for homeowner relief. States are expected to allocate funds beginning Fall 2021. Looking to get by until you can apply? Your success coach can review your budget and offer cost saving tips in the meantime.

He had lost his previous job last spring and got behind on bills. Angela achieved communication with his unresponsive landlord and completed the application. Marketplace Insurance: Get Assistance!

If you need of health insurance through the Marketplace, you may have questions and could benefit from assistance in understanding plans and applying for coverage. Getting help with personal issues can relieve stress so you can focus better on your job.

Success coach assistance. Your success coach can guide you or connect you with an expert in the field. "I needed insurance and didn't know where to turn," said an ERN member employee. "My success coach connected me with someone who knew the details about special enrollment and I found a great option for my family."

Connecting you to resources.

Independent agencies can serve as the "middle man" at no extra cost to the individual with a goal of finding you the best solution for your healthcare needs at the lowest rate.

Open Enrollment. The next Open Enrollment Period begins November 1st, 2021; enroll by December 15th for coverage to begin January 1st, 2022.

Qualifying Life Event. Certain events can make you eligible to enroll such as: loss of coverage; changes in your household (having a baby, divorce or a family death); change in residence (different zip code or county); and other circumstances such as becoming a US citizen or leaving incarceration.

Other options. You can also enroll in Medicaid or the Children's Health Insurance Program if you're eligible with immediate coverage. Sources: www.healthcare.gov; *ERN USA*
